Frank Rosaly is a drummer and composer currently living in Chicago. He has been involved in the improvised and experimental music community for 10 years where he has become an integral part of the Chicago scene, navigating a fine line between the vibrant improvised music, indie-rock, experimental and jazz communities. He contributes much of his time to performing, composing, as well as organizing musical events, while also touring regularly domestically and internationally.

Frank is currently active in many projects throughout Chicago as well as New York and in Europe. He is also involved in the solo project MILLWORK, which is a study in the integration of electronically manipulated percussion instruments, improvising dense sound walls with controlled feedback, over-driven amplified drums and creating soundscapes designed on analog instruments, blending these sounds with more traditional extended techniques on unamplified drum set.
